Mountaineering camp Moiry 3 / Detailed program:

Level 1 alpine mountaineering. Ascent of a PD-AD summit. Our basecamp is the CAS Moiry alpine club hut (Grimentz) in the Val d'anniviers, accommodation in dormitories. Climb to the Moiry hut, rock course, climbing, ice course on the Moiry glacier, climbing and traversing the Couronne de Bréona (3159 m) in the Grimentz valley. Camp for advanced mountaineers who want to continue in alpine mountaineering (with an excellent physical condition and a good level of climbing). For people who already make two week or more of alpine instruction or camps. Lunch take place in nature in the mountains. Breakfast and evening meal take place in the mountain hut, participants help the gardien with the hut tasks.

D1: Welcome to Signy Shell Station on Monday at 10:00 am, minibus to Grimentz. Walk to the CAS hut in Moiry, Alpine instruction.

D2: Multi-pitch Piola route over the Moiry hut (3-5 pitches) with independant teams. The best participants will lead their own independant team over the supervision of the mountain guide. Friends and nuts required in this long route.

D3: Alpine rock instruction: rock ridge techniques, long and short roping, how to protect yourself on a ridge, belay techniques in the high mountains, rappel down on a rock ridge, preparing an alpine rock ridge ascent, route selection and weather, how to get out with bad weather.

D4: alpine glacier instruction: crevasse rescue, simple and double pulley system, ancor system and belay with ice scew on a glacier. Real pratice of a crevasse rescue.

D5: summit ascent of the week : Couronne de Bréona (3159 m) and back to the valley, Minibus trip back to Signy Shell gas station. End of the course at 16 h 00 in Signy.

The climbing instructor is a swiss mountain guide fully qualified. The camp can be cancelled following the conditions or a lack of participants.

Prices:

Our camp prices are for 1 person. They include a swiss mountain guide, half board in a mountain hut, lunch, technical gear, transport from the meeting point. The extra-costs in restaurants, mountain huts are not included.

Group activities:

The instructor/participants ratio respect the swiss safety standards depending the activity. Camps take place in a good atmosphere and respect the well-being of our young participants. Participants who don't respect the team and other participants will be rapidily expeled after a contact with the parents.

Booking:

Your booking is valid only after we received your payment corresponding to the price of the camp.

Cancellation, interruption:

If, whatever reason it is, you cancel the camp after a booking, a restraint of 100 % is counted. Any begun and interrupted camp will not be paid off.

Insurance:

The participants are not assured by the mountain guide or the school. The participant cover itself suitably in health insurance and accidents (including the climbing et mountaineering accidents). Every participant must have a personal rescue insurance (including helicopter rescue). If your child don't have such an insurance, we suggest a formula with the swiss REGA, This insurance cost Sfr.30.- and must be paid before the camp.

Parents responsibility:

The parents assume:

- The full responsibility of the damages caused voluntarily or not voluntarily in the installations or the other objects belonging or rented by PROGRESSION
- Expel costs
- Post costs for forgotten clothes or other objects

Medical file:

Any medical problem must be indicated to PROGRESSION.

Transport:

Every participant comes all on one's own to the meeting point.
